

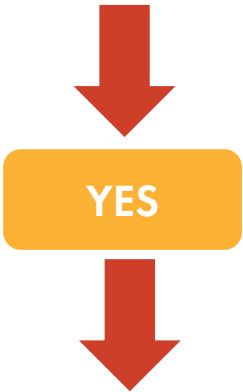
When to Stay Home

Is the Student or a Member of the Household experiencing COVID-19-like symptoms? Please see the attached poster for list of symptoms.



- Stay home or leave campus, call your doctor, and contact the School Health Office (nurse@steiner.edu) to coordinate next steps before returning to school
- To ensure a safe return to school, the School reserves the right to require a negative COVID-19 test

Is the Student or a Member of the Household awaiting test results for COVID-19 or tested positive for COVID-19?



- Stay home and contact the School Health Office (nurse@steiner.edu) to report test results
- If tested positive and suspected exposure to cohort, begin cohort 10-day quarantine and coordinate return to school with the School Health Office

Is the Student or a Member of the Household required to self-quarantine due to recent travel or hosting of a traveler according to New York State guidelines?



- 10-day quarantine or test-out option with two negative tests
- Contact the School Health Office (nurse@steiner.edu) prior to travel or hosting to discuss quarantine and testing requirements
- Coordinate return to school with School Health Office

Has the Student or a Member of the Household been within six feet of anyone with confirmed COVID-19 virus or with COVID-19 symptoms without a negative COVID-19 test for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more? Exception may apply to fully-vaccinated individuals.



- 10-day quarantine counted from last day of exposure regardless of COVID testing results for Student/Household Member
- Contact the School Health Office (nurse@steiner.edu) to discuss quarantine, possible exception and coordinate when to return to school
