



# When to Stay Home

Is the Student or a Member of the Household experiencing COVID-19-like symptoms? Please see the [CDC's list of symptoms](#).

YES

- Stay home or leave campus, call your doctor, and contact the School Health Office ([nurse@steiner.edu](mailto:nurse@steiner.edu)) to coordinate next steps before returning to school
- To ensure a safe return to school, the School reserves the right to require a negative COVID-19 test

Is the Student or a Member of the Household awaiting test results for COVID-19 or have they tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 14 days?

YES

- Stay home and contact the School Health Office ([nurse@steiner.edu](mailto:nurse@steiner.edu)) to report test results
- If tested positive and suspected exposure to cohort, begin cohort quarantine as applicable
- Coordinate return to school with the School Health Office

Has the Student or a Member of the Household recently traveled or hosted a traveler?

YES

- Test 72 hours prior to international travel ([see CDC quarantine and testing guidelines](#))
- Contact the School Health Office ([nurse@steiner.edu](mailto:nurse@steiner.edu)) prior to travel/hosting to discuss quarantine & testing requirements
- Coordinate return to school with School Health Office

Has the Student or a Member of the Household been in close contact with anyone with a confirmed COVID-19 infection or with COVID-19 symptoms without a negative COVID-19 test? Exception may apply to fully-vaccinated individuals.

YES

- 10-day quarantine counted from last day of exposure regardless of COVID testing results for Student/Household Member
- Contact the School Health Office ([nurse@steiner.edu](mailto:nurse@steiner.edu)) to discuss quarantine, possible exception and coordinate when to return to school
